Recycling Reminders

Under state law and Boro Ordinance #493, it is mandatory for Boro residents to recycle. If you are on the Boro's trash program, the following items are recyclable: Plastic containers and bottles #1 through #7; steel and aluminum cans; glass jars and bottles; all cardboard boxes; empty paper towel and toilet paper rolls; office and shredded paper; phone books and paperback books. All of these items can go in the same green recycling bin.

Tree Branch Trimming

Tree limbs hanging above your sidewalk must be cut at least 7 ft. above the sidewalk. All shrubs encroaching the sidewalk must also be trimmed back so they are not touching the sidewalk. If this is not completed by 7/14, the Boro plans to do the trimming
