SNOW REMOVAL REMINDER

Snow is to be removed from sidewalks within 12 hours after the snow has fallen. It is NOT to be thrown or placed on the street. Ice should also be treated for safe walking.

TAX REMINDER

When paying your Spring Taxes at the Boro Office, be sure to bring both halves of the bill so your half can be receipted! There is a \$1 charge for a copy of the previous year's paid tax receipt.

RECYCLING REMINDERS

Under state law and Boro Ordinance #493, it is mandatory for Boro residents to recycle. If you are on the Boro's trash program, the following items are recyclable: plastic containers and bottles #1 through #7; steel and aluminum cans; glass jars and bottles; all cardboard boxes; empty paper towel and toilet paper rolls; office and shredded paper; phone books, paperback books and magazines. All of these items can go in the same recycling bin. Cell Phones, CFLs and unused/unwanted prescription drugs can be dropped off at the Boro Office Monday- Friday 8-4:30.

REFUSE UPDATES

You are able to pay your refuse at a \$10 discount for the entire year (\$175) by January 31, 2015. If you wish to do this, simply add \$175 to the total water/sewer amounts. There is no fee for yardwaste bags this year. They will be available in the lobby beginning March 27.

- 10/22, 11/5, 11/19, 12/3, 12/10—Fall Leaf/Yardwaste Pick-up
