Pavilion & Restroom Replacement Project Concluded

The Community Memorial Park Board's project to replace the former old bathhouse and the Rotary and Hart pavilions has been successfully completed. Through its special capital campaign, community and businesses' financial support and in-kind donations, the Board attained its initial fundraising goal of \$55,000, as well as committed its reserves to provide more comprehensive and esthetically pleasing facilities. The project's final cost was \$150,000. New Holland Toyota and the service organization the Independent Order of Odd Fellows both stepped up to lead the Capital Campaign. Along with these improvements, additional security cameras have been added throughout the Park to reduce vandalism and enhance Park safety.
