SNOW REMOVAL REMINDER

Snow must be removed from sidewalks within 12 hours after the snow has fallen. It is NOT to be placed on the street. Ice should also be treated for safe walking.

TAX REMINDER

When paying your Spring Taxes at the Boro Office, be sure to bring both halves of the bill so that your half can be receipted! There is a \$1 charge for a copy of the previous year's paid tax receipt.

PRESCRIPTION DRUG DROP BOX

The New Holland Police Department is happy to participate with the Lancaster County District Attorney in his effort to reduce the illicit use of prescription medications. There is a drop box for unused and/or unwanted prescription drugs at the Boro Office. The box will be available for drop offs between 8 and 4:30 pm M-F. The collected medications will be picked up regularly and disposed of in a safe & environmentally responsible manner.

COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING

Under New Holland Boro Ordinance #493, recycling is MANDATORY for all Boro residents and businesses. Additional items have now been added for recycling: magazines, plastics #1- #7 and aerosol cans. A complete list of recyclable items is on the back of this paper. The Boro Office also has a drop-off during regular business hours for cell phones. Prices for additional refuse needs are: Red tags (oversized items--\$10); Green tags (yardwaste--\$1.50); Yellow tags (extra bags--\$2); Purple tags (tires--\$3); White tags (appliances--\$15); Recycle Bins--\$7

If you are on the Boro's Trash program, the following items must be recycled:

METAL:

- *Aluminum beverage cans
- *Steel food & beverage cans, aerosol cans, paint cans

GLASS:

- *Clear, brown, blue and green glass food and beverage containers

PLASTIC:

- *#1 through #7
 - *Remove caps/lids
 - *Rinse thoroughly to remove all contaminants
 - *It is OK to leave on labels and neck rings

PAPER & CARDBOARD:

*Please break down boxes as flat as possible and put them out next to your recycle bin if they do not fit in your bin

- *All sizes of cardboard boxes
 - *Clean pizza boxes (no oil marks)
 - *Food boxes (i.e. cereal & gelatin boxes)
 - *Empty paper towel and toilet paper rolls
 - *Paperboard packaging (i.e. tissue boxes)
 - *Office paper (any color)
 - *Shredded paper (in CLEAR plastic bags)
 - *Newspapers and inserts
 - ***Magazines, catalogs and brochures**
 - *Envelopes & junk mail
 - *Paper bags
 - *Phone books and other soft cover books

- Remove all packaging (Styrofoam, peanuts, plastic bubble wrap, plastic liners, etc.)
 - Flatten ALL boxes
 - Bundle all cardboard that does not fit into the recycling bin
 - Cover loose paper with heavier items to prevent it from blowing away
 - If the weather forecast calls for high winds or wet weather, keep your paper recyclables until the next week.
