Amendments. 20 21 A. Code Chapter 7 (Fire Prevention & Fire Protection), Part 1 (Regulating Fires & 22 23 Burning), §102 (Definitions) is amended by deleting the definition of "COOK STOVE OR GRILL" in its entirety and replacing it with the following new definition: 24 25 26 COOK STOVE, CHIMINEA, OR BUILT-IN GRILL - Any device providing a 27 small enclosed area designed for cooking or providing heat, where the fuel for a fire contained therein is wood, charcoal, coal, liquid propane gas, or natural gas. 28 29 B. Code Chapter 7 (Fire Prevention & Fire Protection), Part 1 (Regulating Fires & 30 Burning), §103 (Prohibition on Burning) is amended by deleting §103 in its entirety and 31 32 replacing same with the following new §103: 33 34 Prohibition on Burning. After the effective date of this Part, with the 35 exception of (a) a fire cook stove, outdoor cooking smoker, chiminea, outdoor patio fixture, or corn roaster designed to burn wood or coal, which also shall have a 36 cover, dome or wire mesh to keep embers from escaping, and (b) propane or natural 37 gas grill fires that do not require a cover when in use, no person shall kindle nor 38 39 maintain, nor authorize another person to kindle nor maintain, any open fire within 40 the Borough of New Holland for the purpose of disposal or elimination of any waste, 41 or any excess or unwanted material, regardless of whether such open fire is in a pit, 42 incinerator, barrel, device, or other or no container. This Section, however, shall 43 not be deemed to prohibit the burning of any material in any furnace, or as a 44 necessary part of any industrial or manufacturing process, so long as such burning

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is not solely for the purpose of elimination of waste, or excess or unwanted material.

All such containers, when used as permitted by this Section, shall be located a

minimum distance from every property line of not less than the side yard

Section 2. Repealer Clause.

All provisions of the Code that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of, but only with respect to, the subject matter of this Ordinance. All other provisions of the Code shall remain in full force and effect as heretofore adopted.

Section 3. Severability Clause.

If any word, sentence, clause, section, part, or other provision of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining words, sentences, clauses, sections, parts, or other provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid words, sentences, clauses, sections, parts, or other provisions thereof not been included herein.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the passage thereof.
