Street Sweeping

The Boro will be using the same approach for its Street Sweeping process this spring.

Make a note of where your address is on the schedule below and make sure your vehicles are removed from the street on the appropriate day. The streets will be scheduled (depending on weather) as follows:

Tuesday, April 21: EVEN number side of all streets **NORTH** of Main St. {including cul de sacs, dead ends and all of the north side of Main St.}

Wednesday, April 22: ODD number side of all streets **NORTH** of Main St.

Thursday, April 23: EVEN number side of all streets **SOUTH** of Main Street {including cul de sacs, dead ends and all of the south side of Main St.}

Friday, April 24: ODD number side of all streets **SOUTH** of Main St.

Street Overlay Work Scheduled

The streets set for repaving this year are: Sections of Mentzer, West Spruce, Willow, Walnut and Locust. The work is projected to start the week of June 2. Property owners affected will be notified.

Sewer Clean-Out and Vent Pipes

Make sure you know where your sewer vent and clean-out pipes are in your yard in case you have a sewer emergency. The vent is the pipe closest to the house with holes in the lid to allow air flow. The clean-out is closer to the street and will have a solid lid. The vent needs to be kept free of plantings and mulch.

Update Your Information

Is your info updated with the Boro office? If your phone number changes, call the office (717-354-4567) to change it. The Boro uses this feature to contact you if there is some sort of important info that our residents need to know. (Examples: Water Break Emergency, Trash Service Delay)

Stormwater Pollution Prevention

Stormwater is water that runs off surfaces such as roofs, roads, etc. when it rains or snow melts. Runoff that does not seep into the ground will go into drains or low spots which lead to streams/creeks. You are able to help keep our streams healthy by picking up after your pet; washing your car in your yard instead of your driveway and keeping leaves and grass clippings out of the road so the storm drains won't get clogged. Sewer Backup or Water Leak

If you have a sewer line backup or a water leak after the normal Boro public works working hours of 7 a.m.- 3:30 p.m. weekdays, you should first contact your plumber to see if it is in your service line. If you call the Boro after hours and an employee responds and identifies the issue as the property owner's responsibility, the owner is responsible for the cost of the response and will be billed by the Boro.

Yard Sales

You must register at the Boro for a YARD SALE and may only use Boro signs around town. Earl Twp. residents are reminded that only signs obtained from the Boro Office (\$2 for the allowable two signs) may be posted in the Boro, all others will be removed.

Pool & Golf Info

Pool info and membership forms should be available on the Boro's website and at the Office in mid-April. A \$10 pool membership discount is applied if paid by 5/8. Opening day for the pool is planned at this time to be Saturday, 6/6. Group and Private Swim Lessons are currently planned on being available.

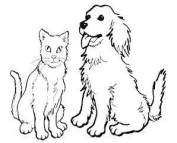

Yard Waste Bag Locations

Yard waste bags are available for purchase from the Boro Office for \$.50 each. Please put the money in an envelope, place it in the drop box beside the front door and take the bags from the black bin. They will also be available at the Golf Shop in the Seymour building at Community Memorial Park when there is staff in the Golf Shop.

Building Permits

No work should be done on your structure or property without first contacting the Boro Office to see if a Building Permit is required.
